

# HARVARD CAPS HARRIS POLL



Field Dates: September 13-14, 2023



## SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **September 12-14, 2023** among **2,103 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.

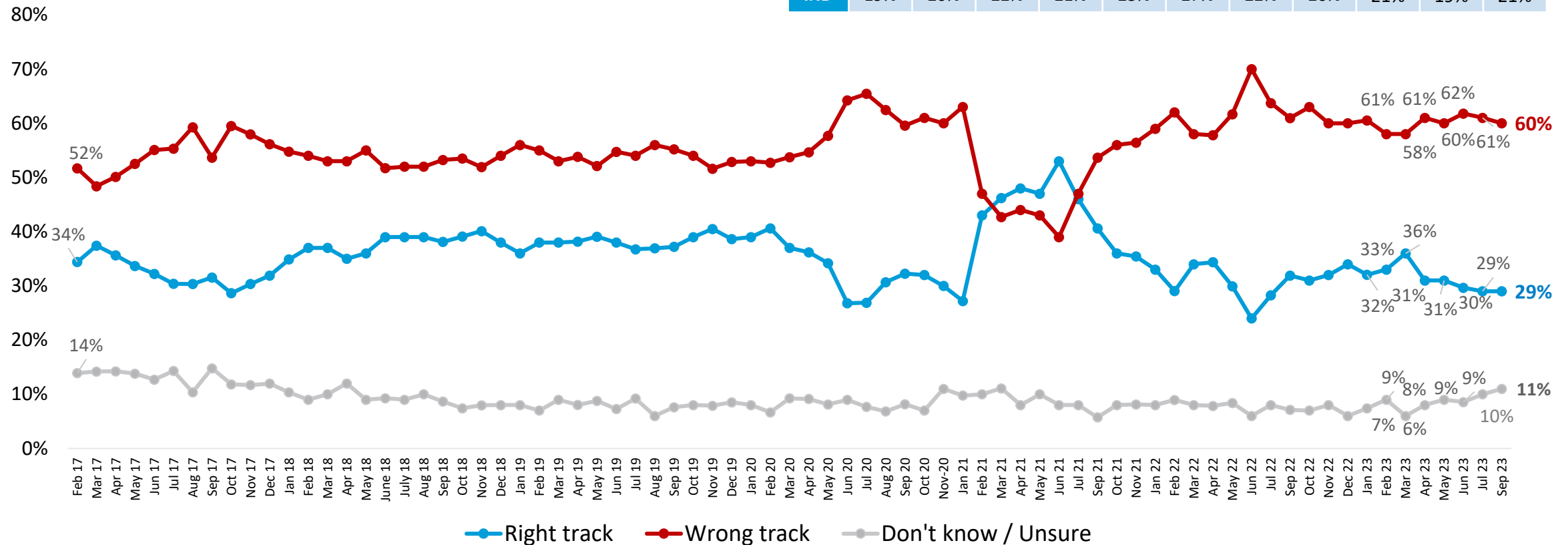

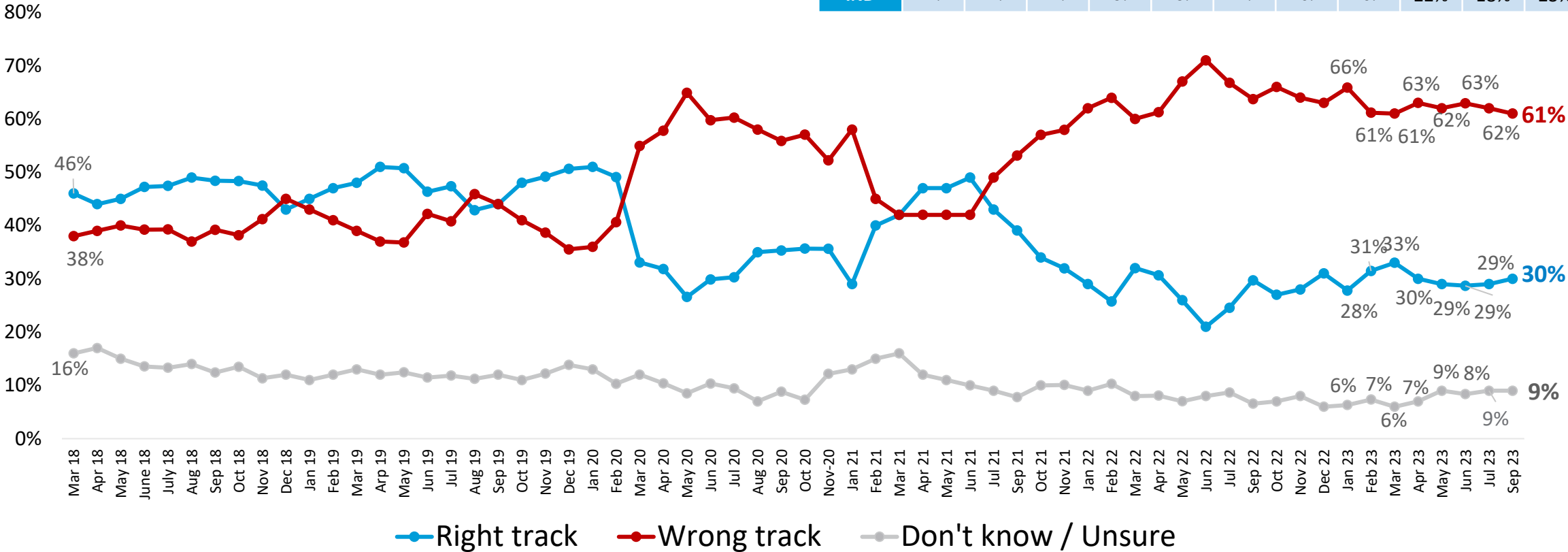

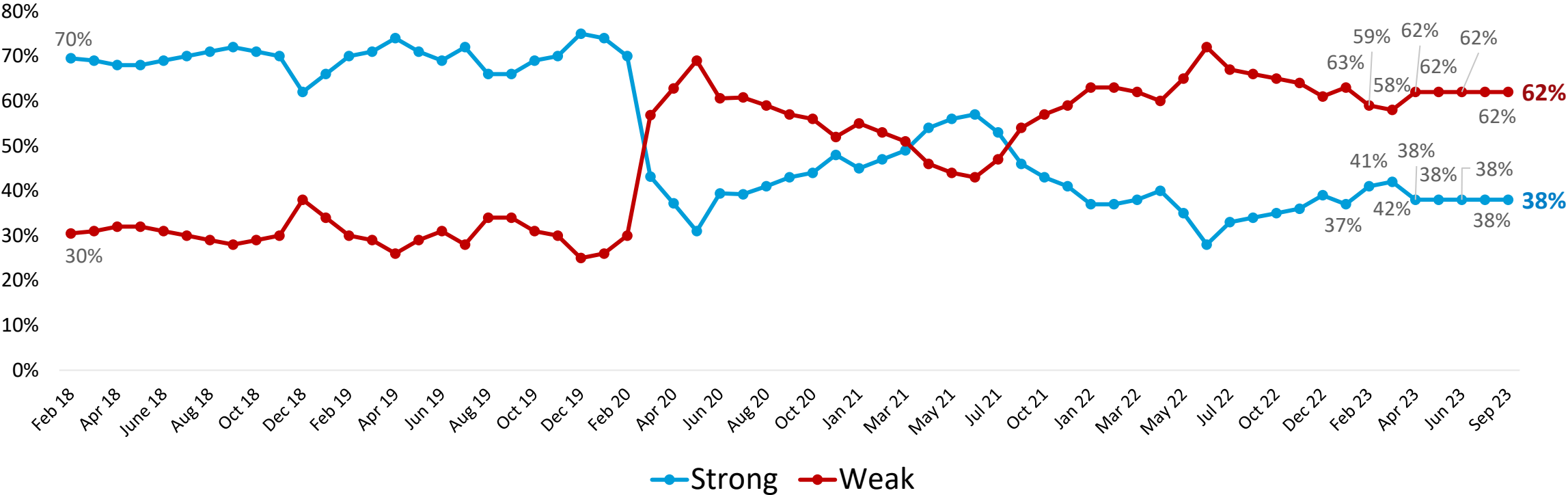
## U.S. Economy: Right Track / Wrong Track

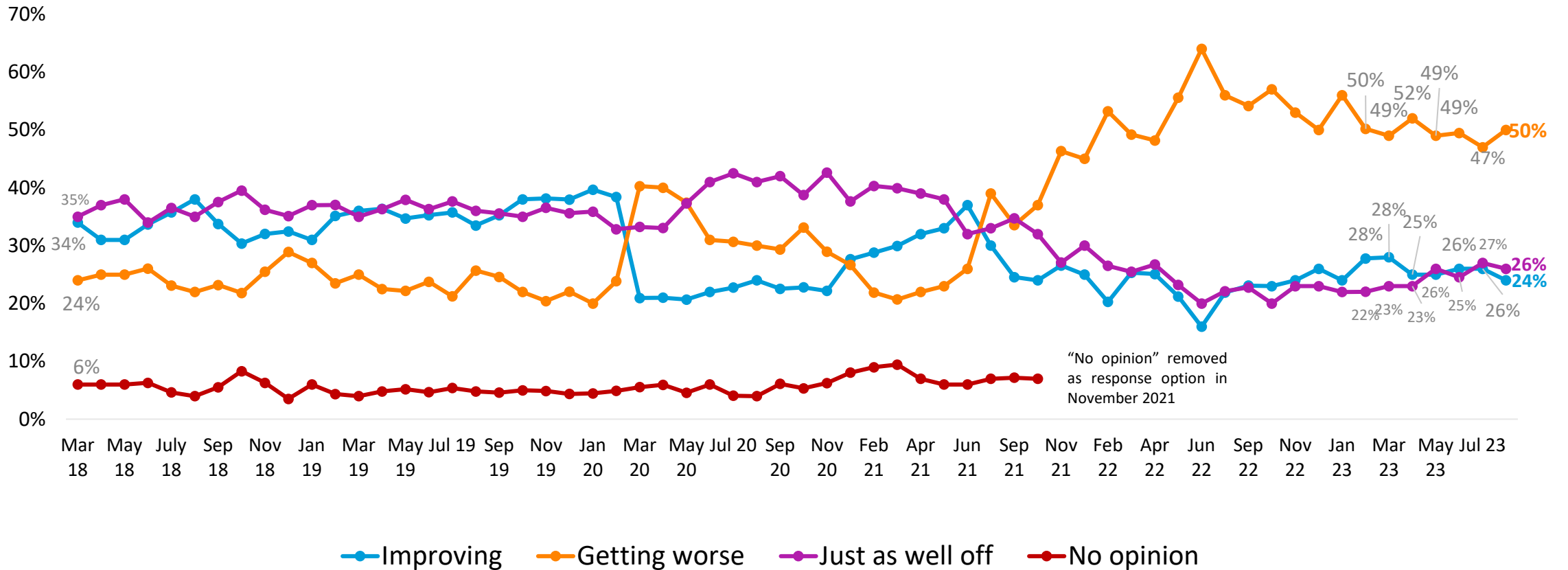

### How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?



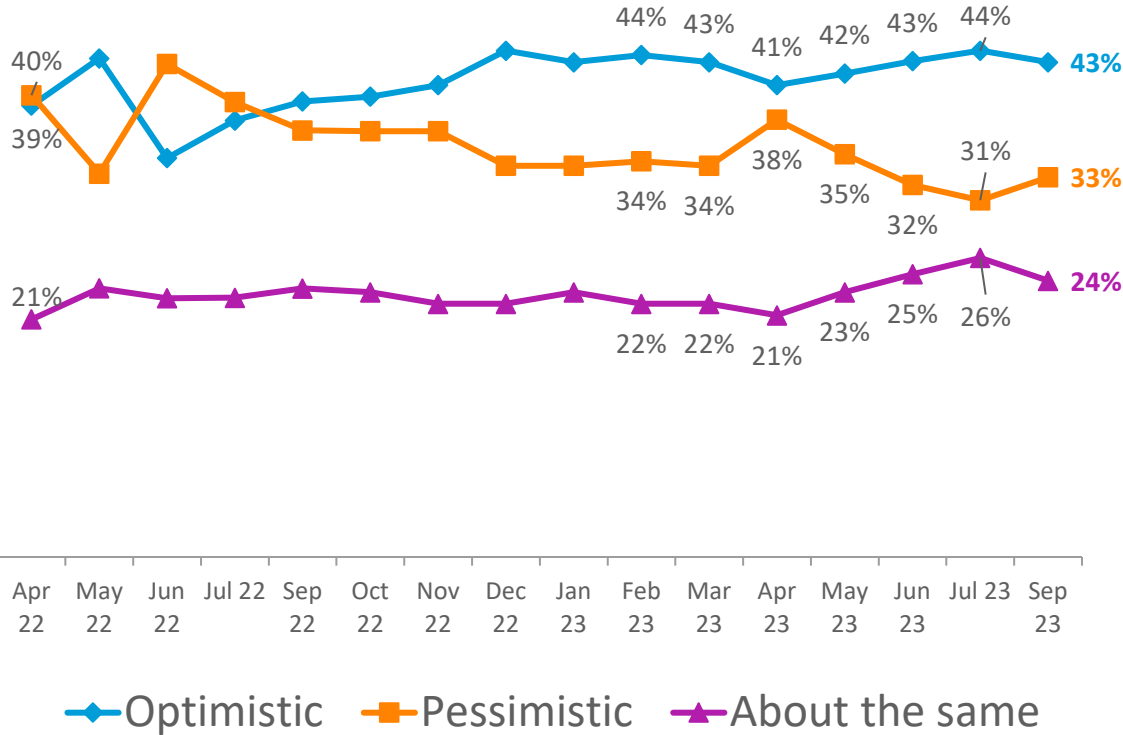
# HALF OF VOTERS SAY THEIR PERSONAL FINANCIAL SITUATION IS GETTING WORSE

## Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?

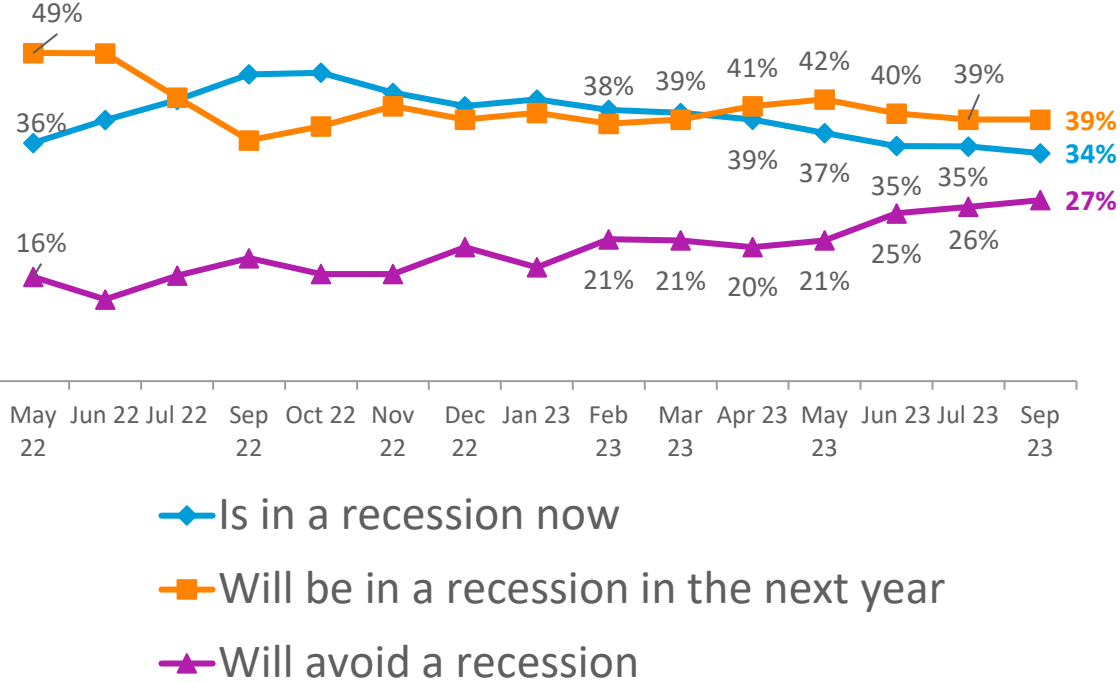

Do you think the U.S. is in a recession now, will be in a recession in the next year or most likely will avoid a recession?

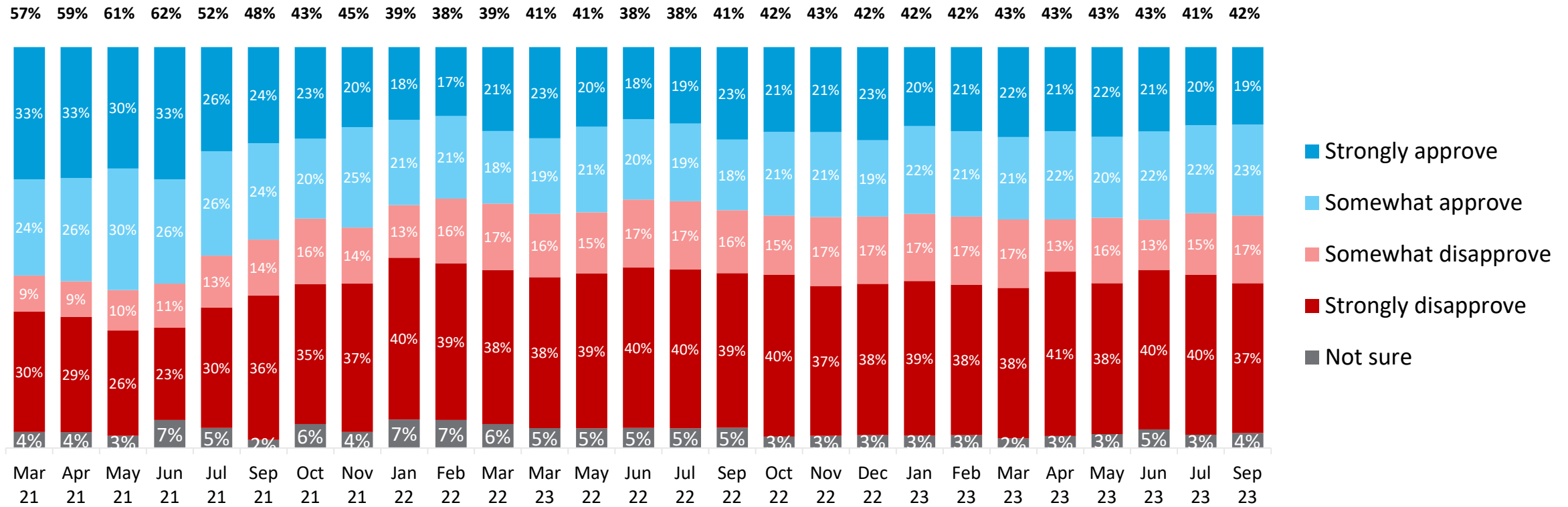

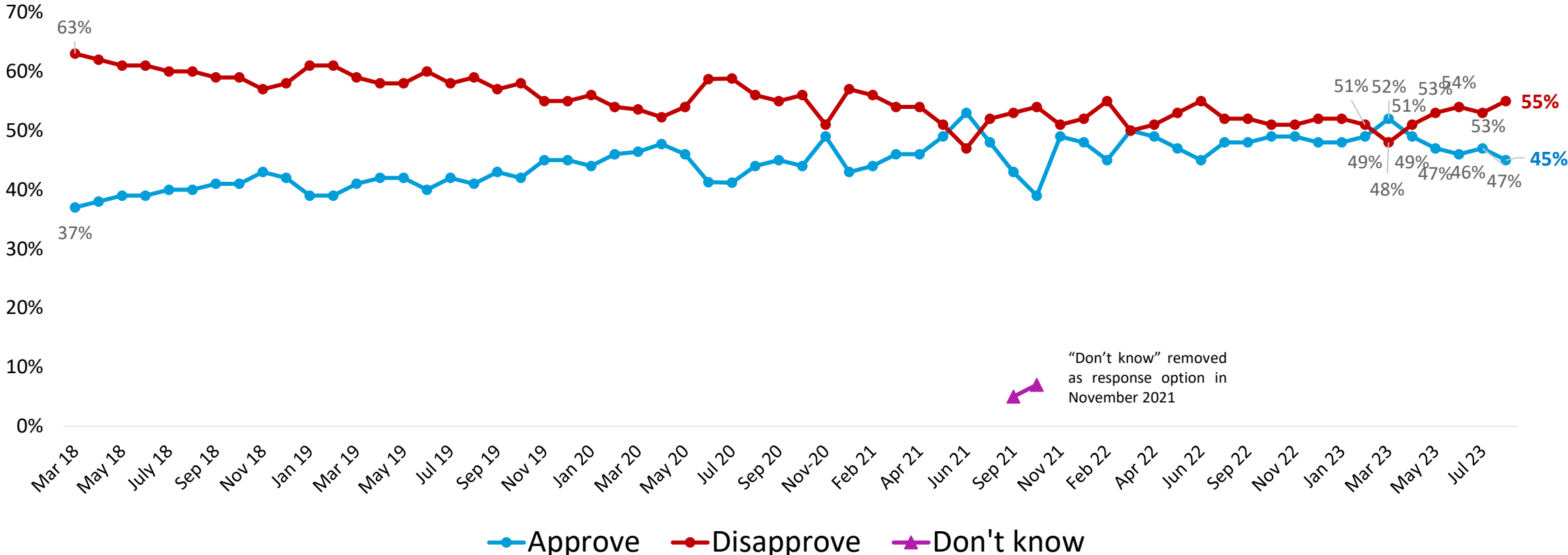

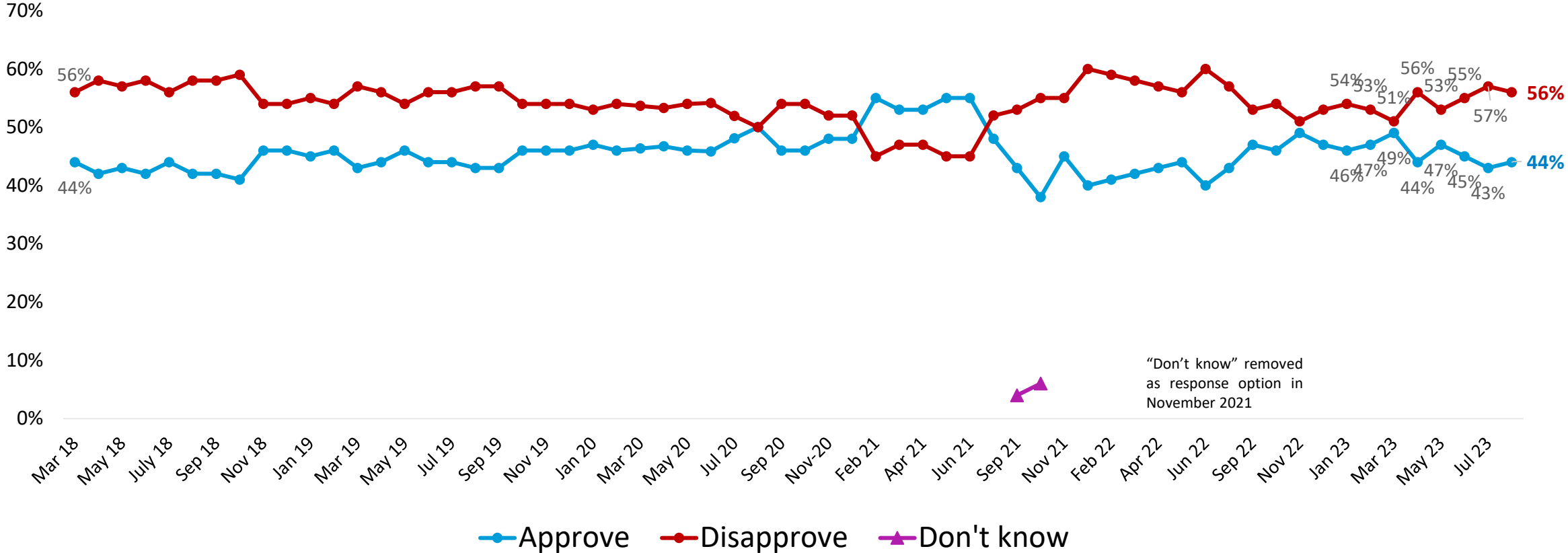

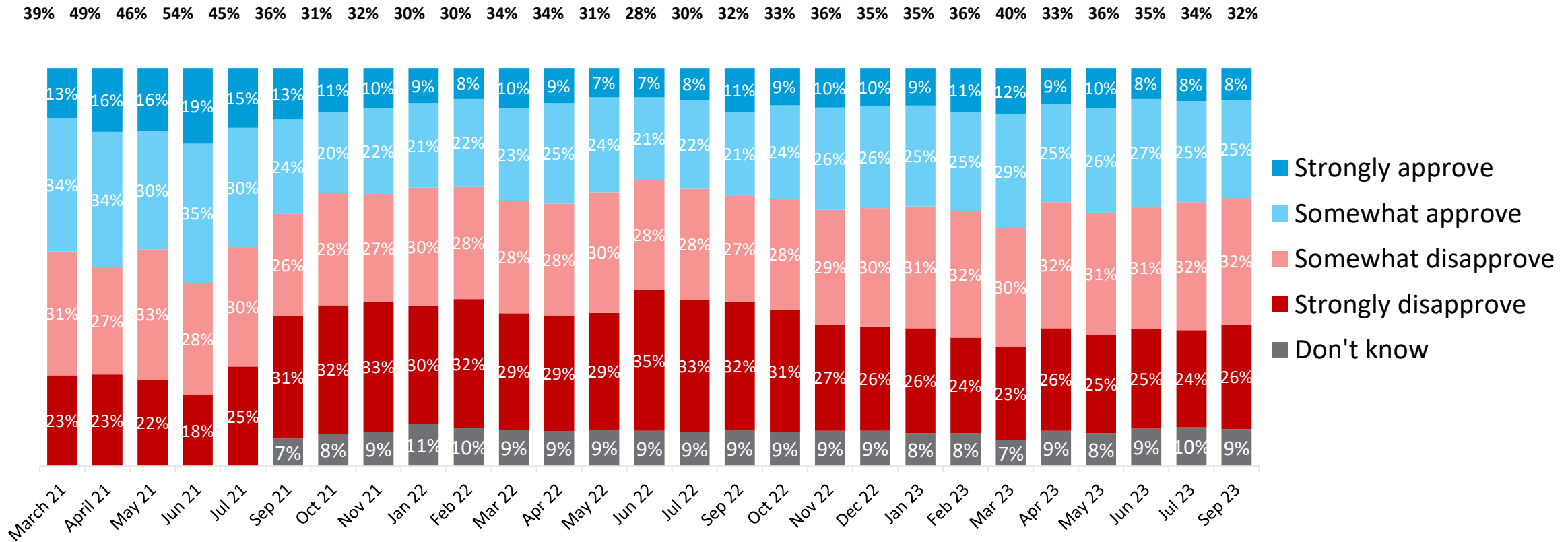

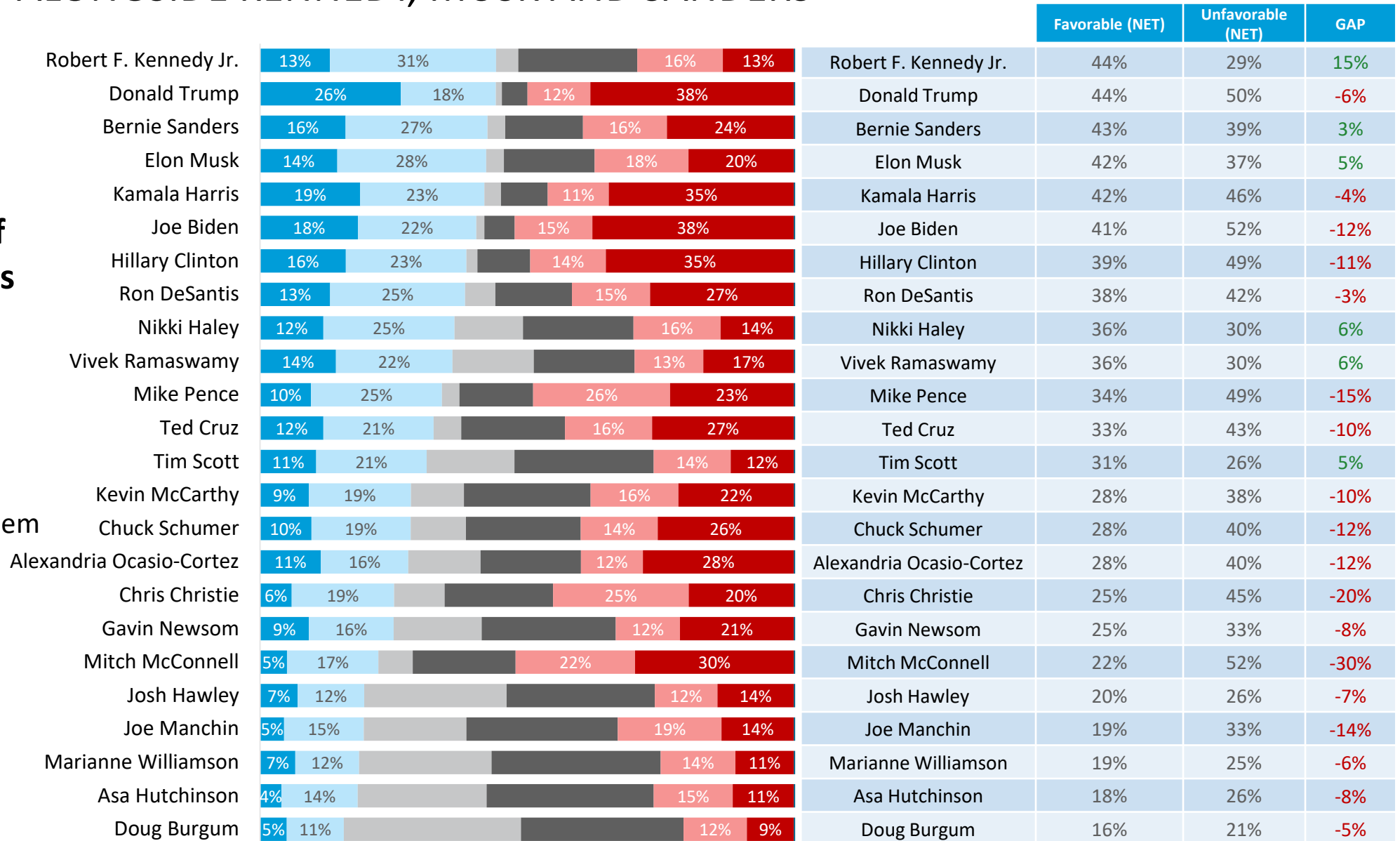

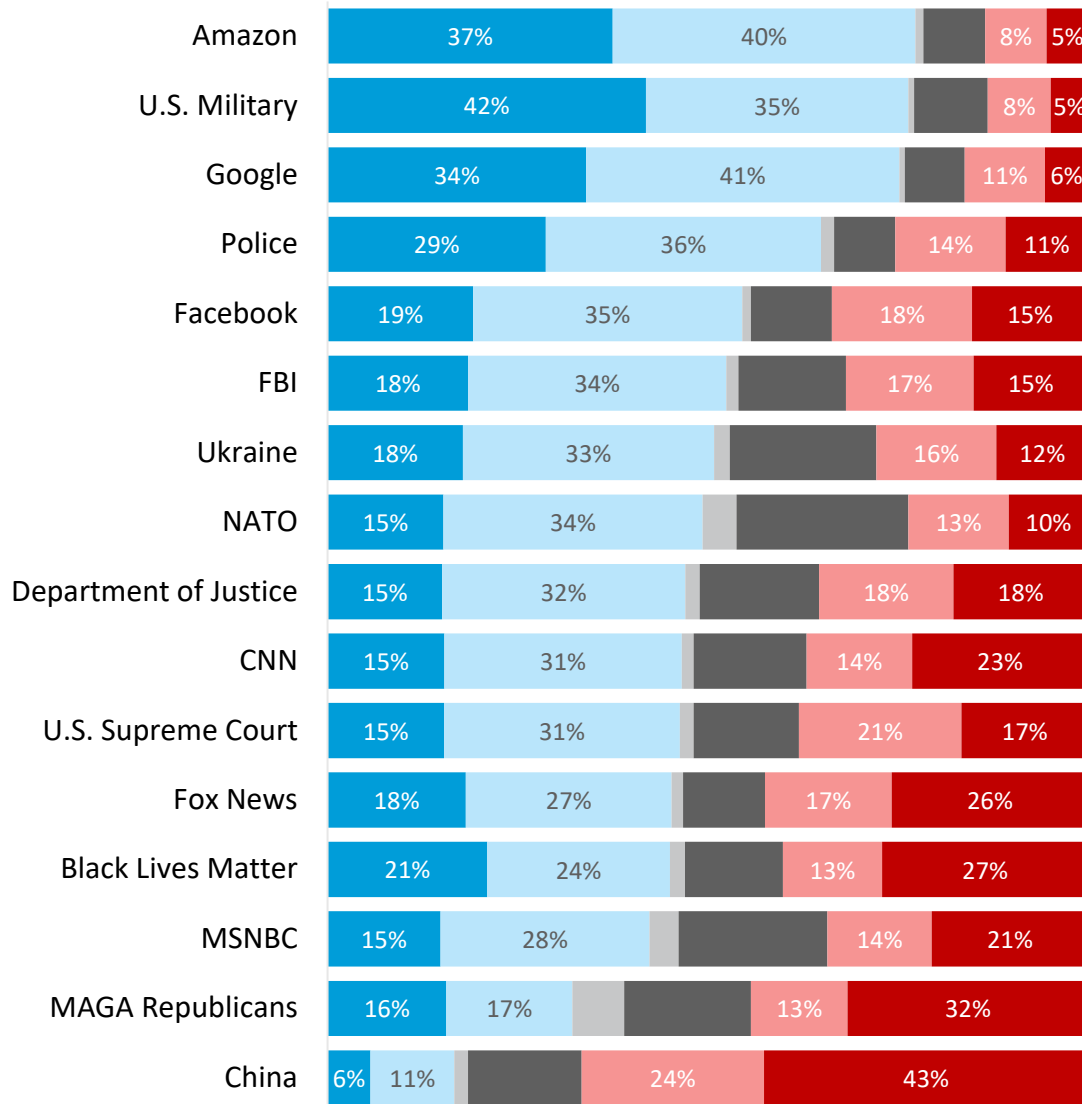

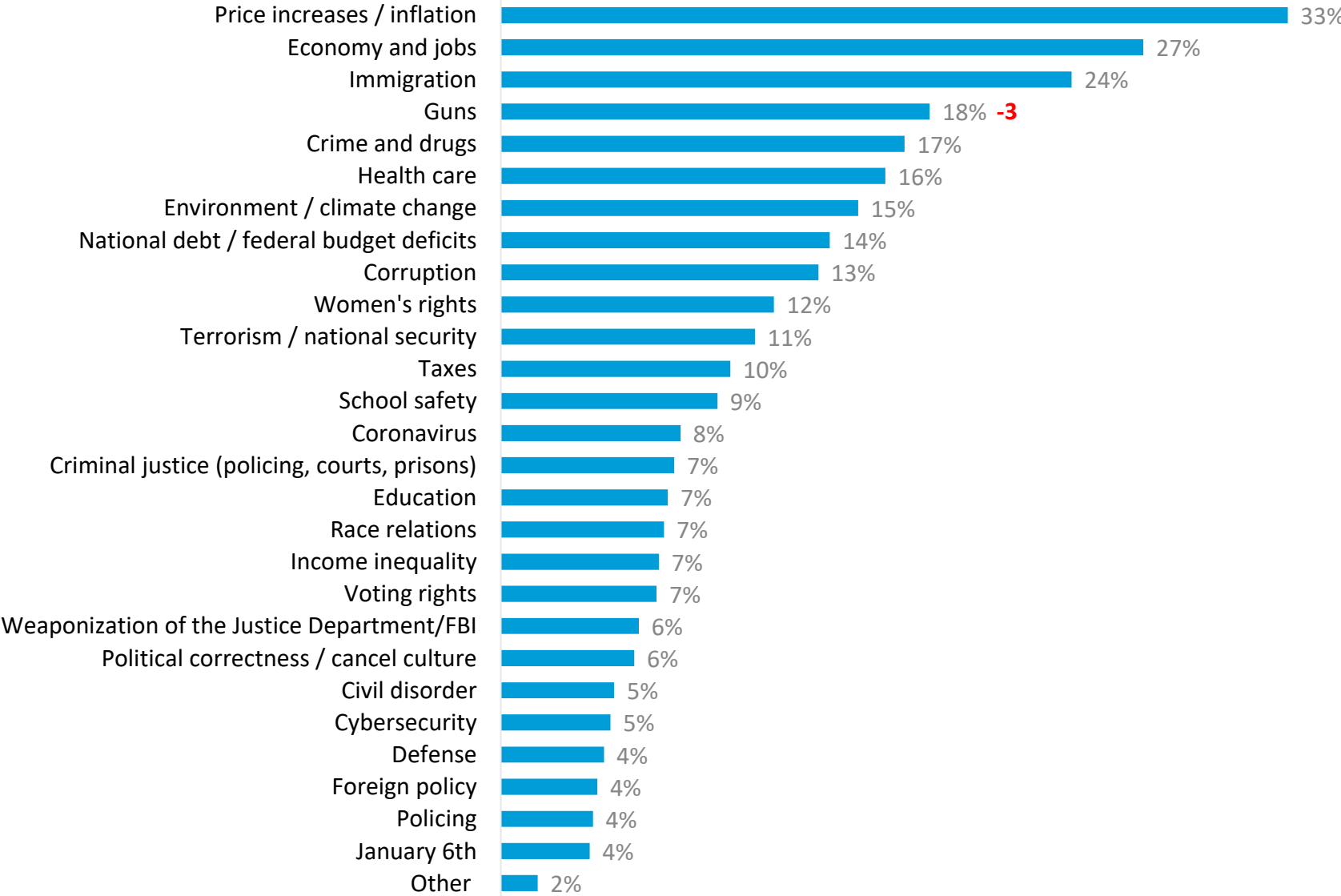

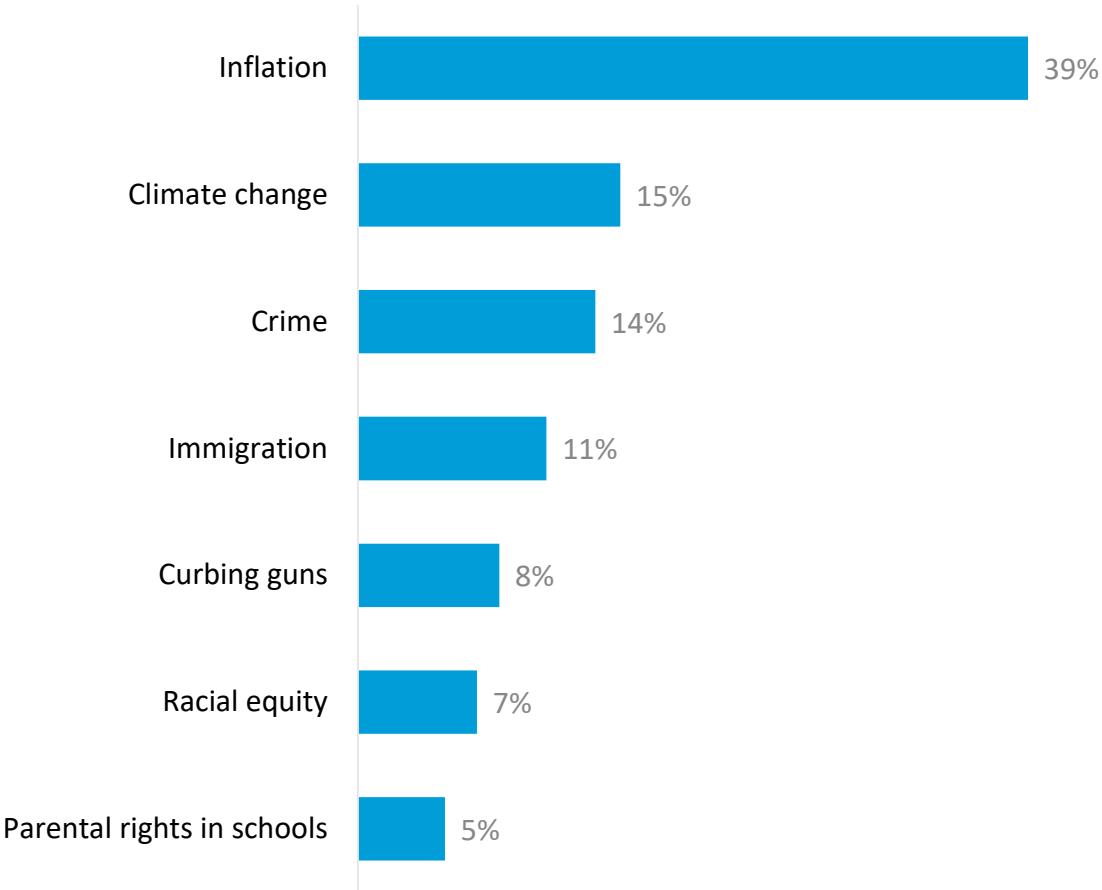

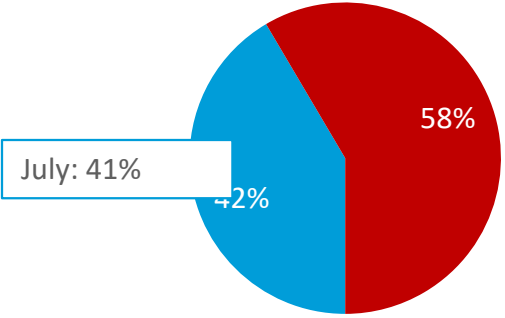

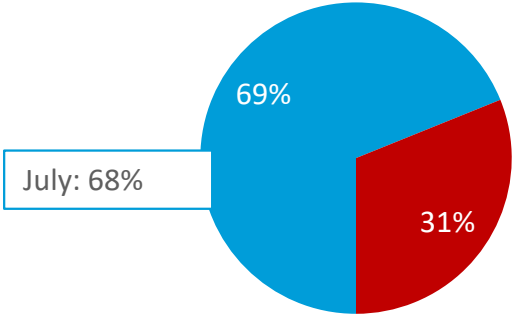

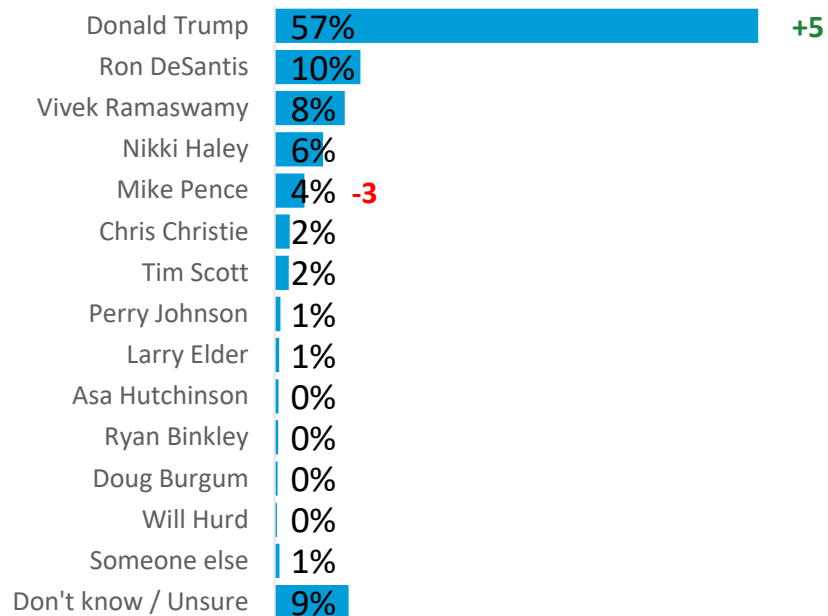

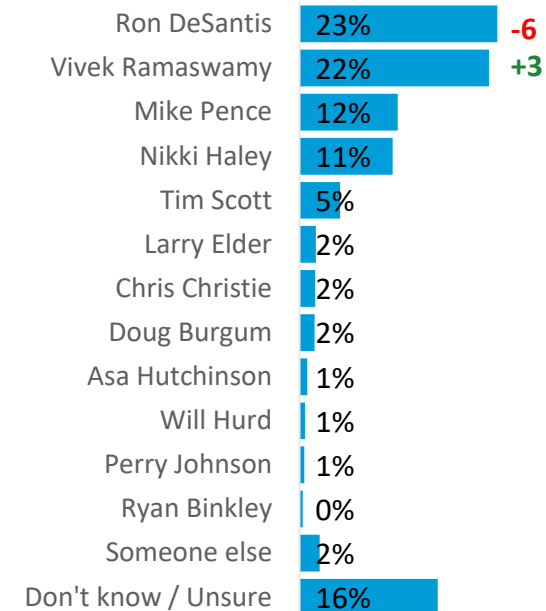

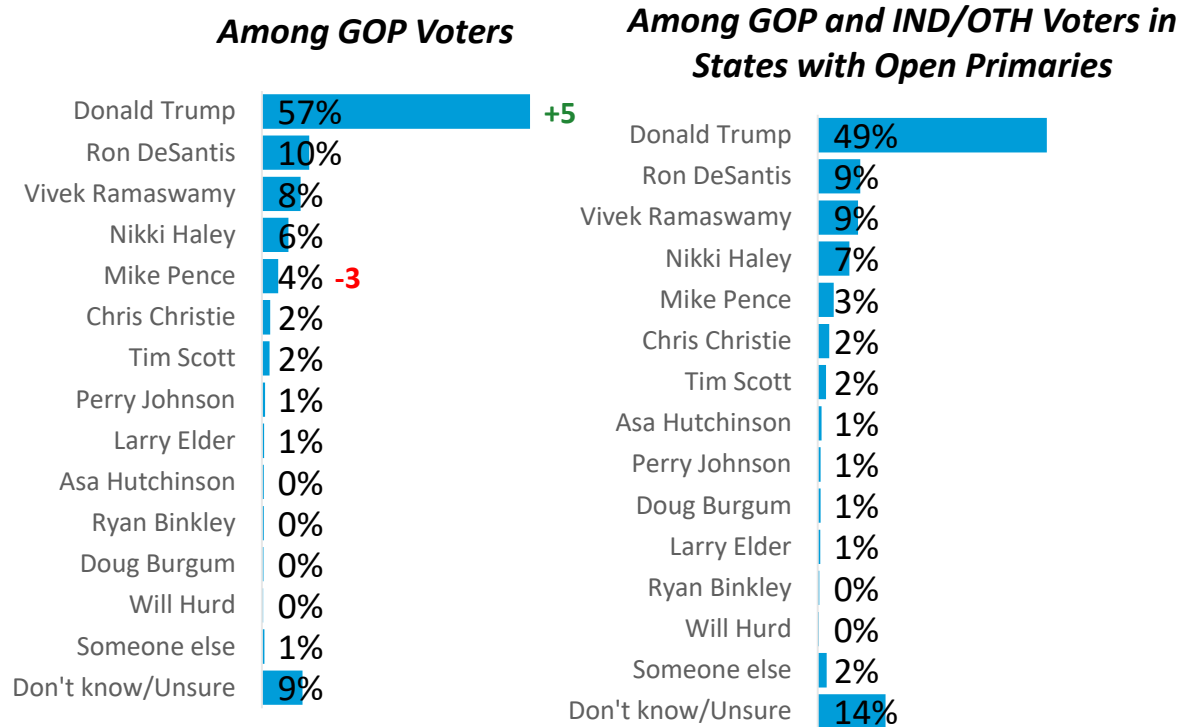

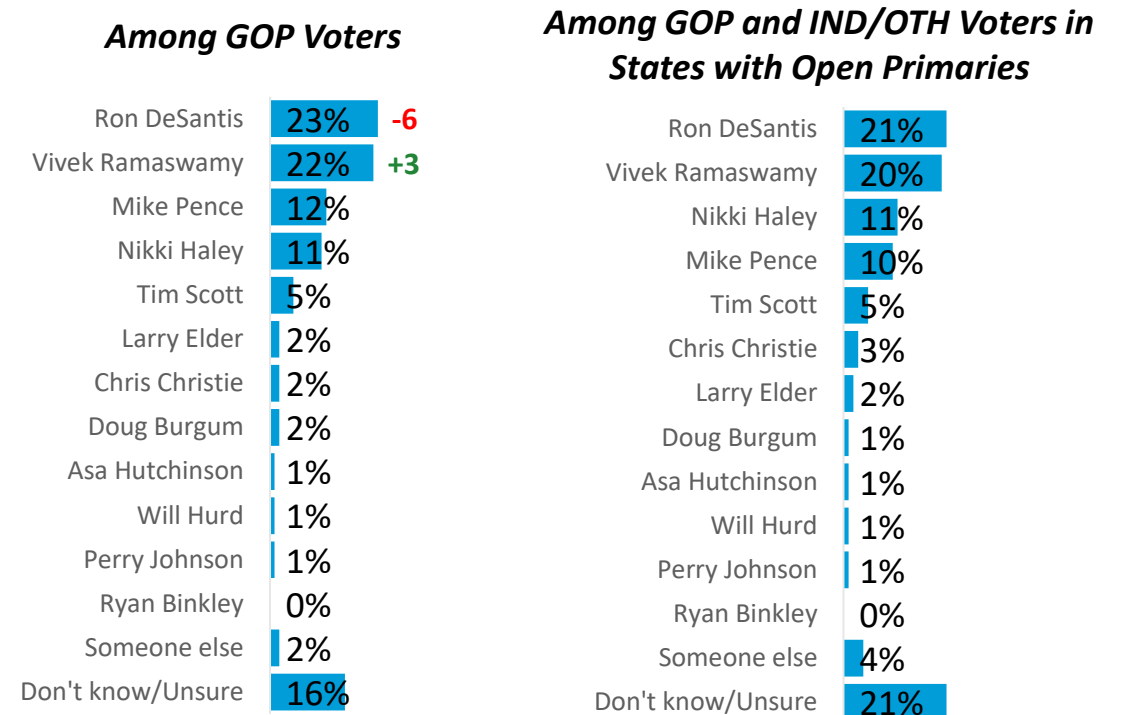

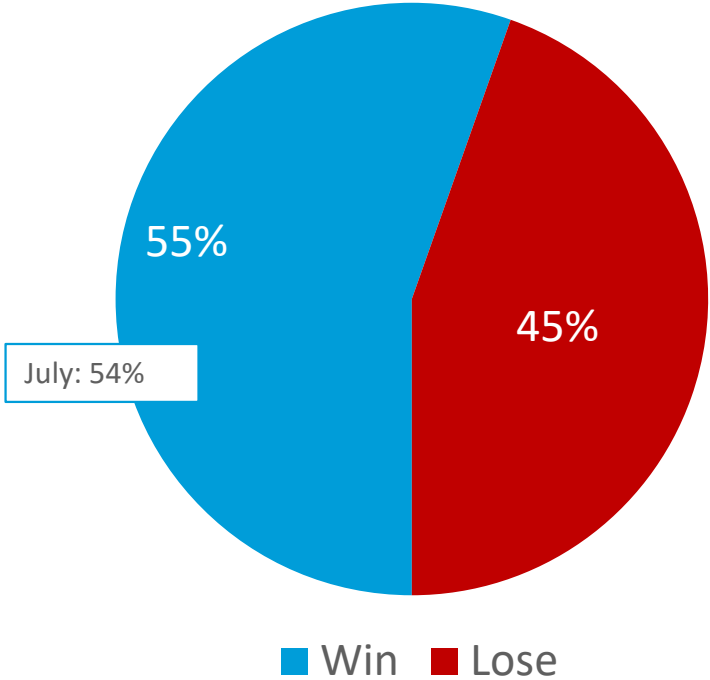

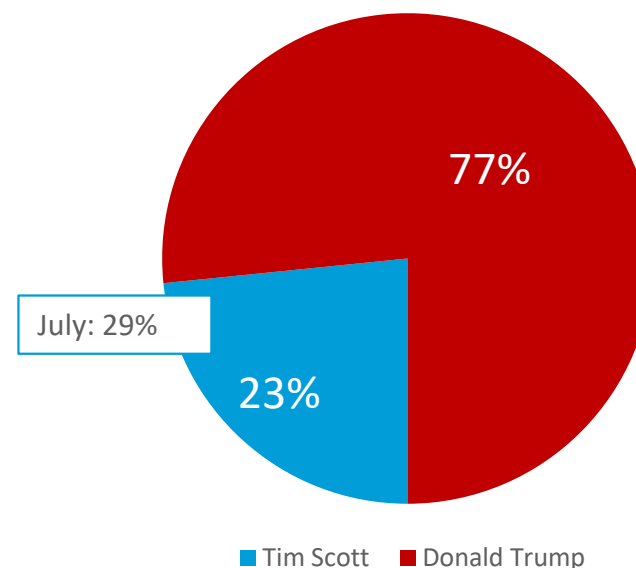
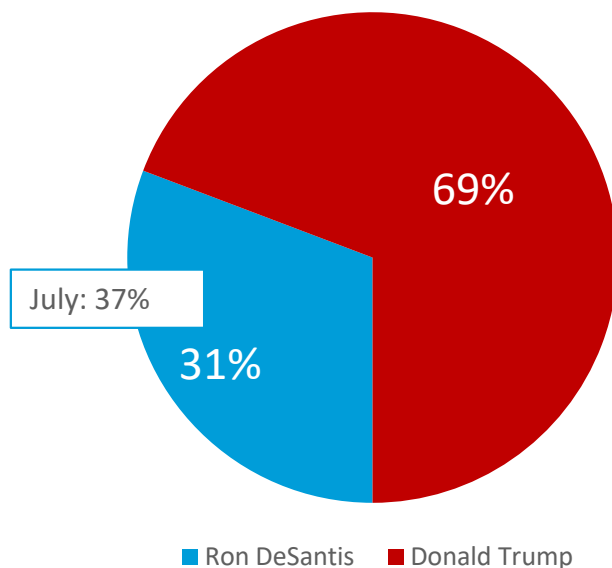

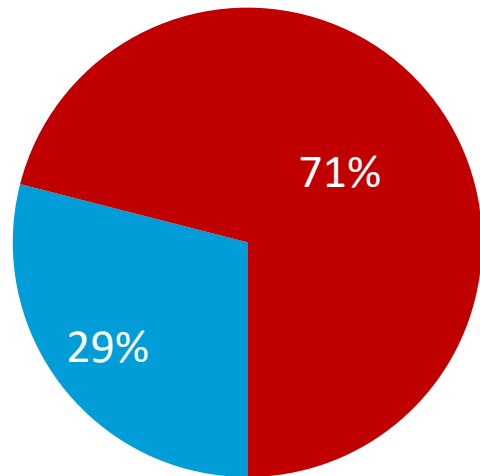

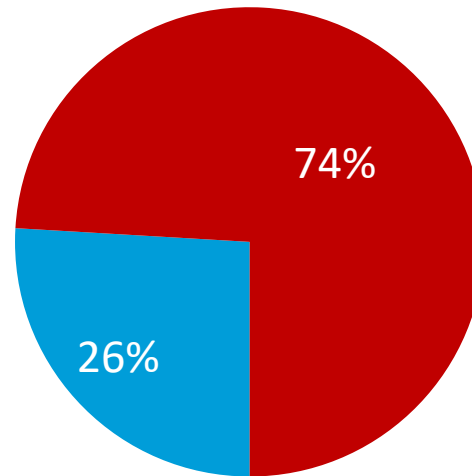

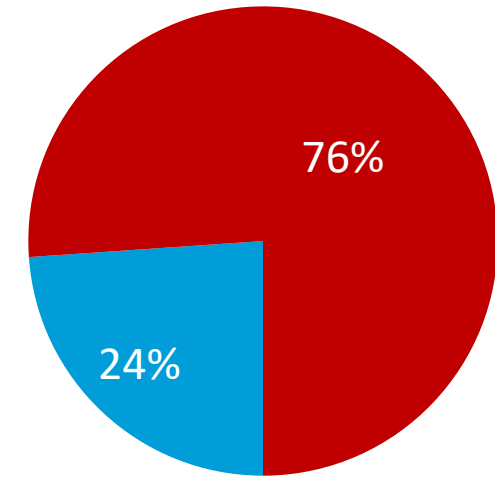

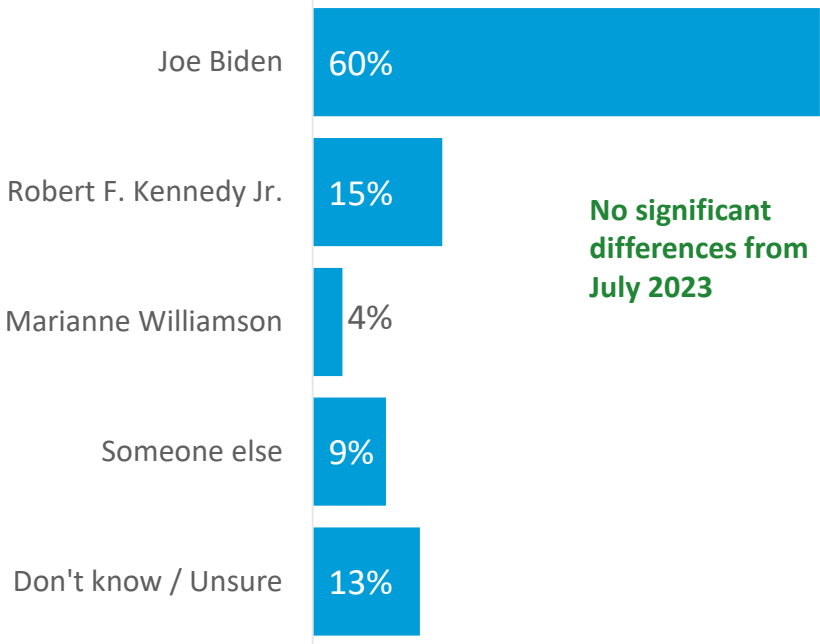

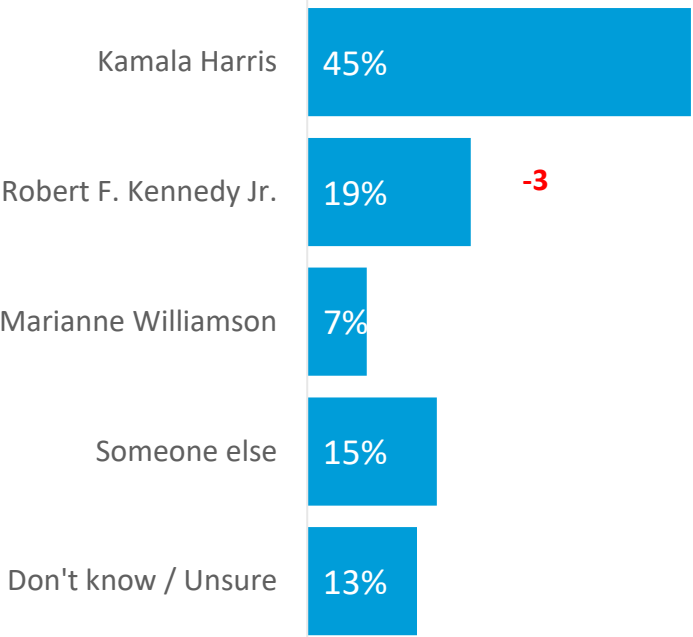

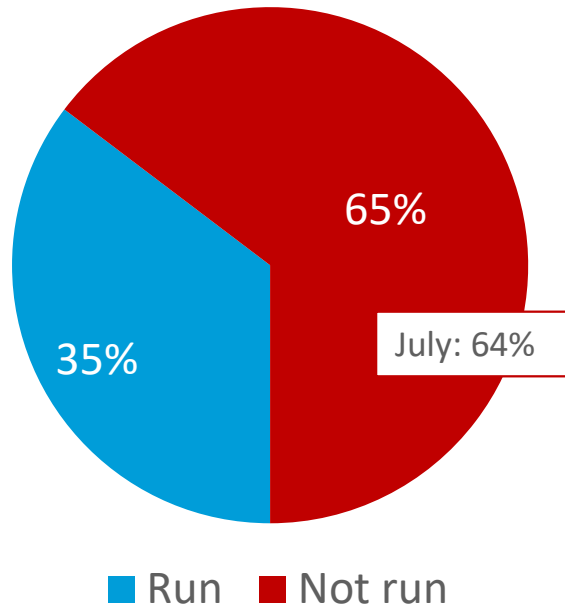

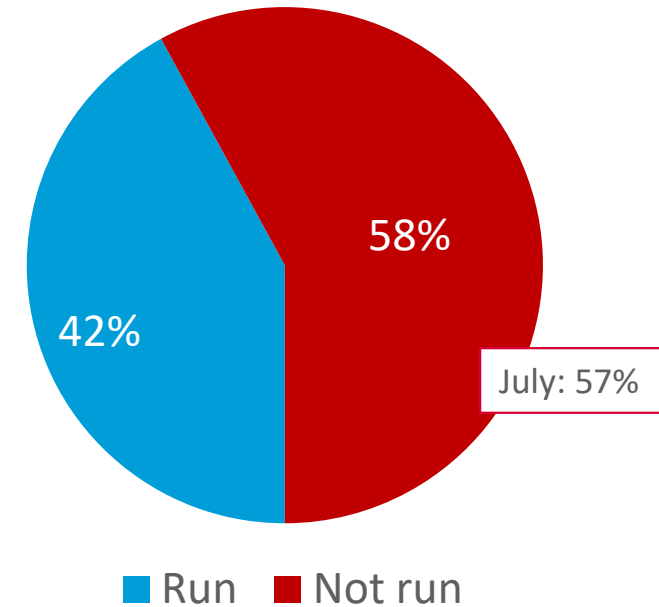

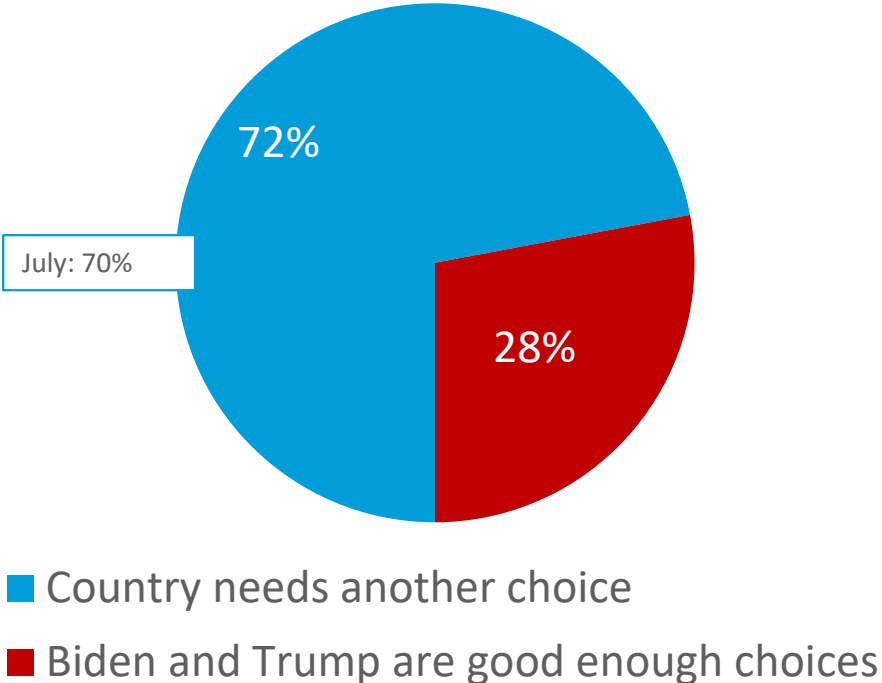

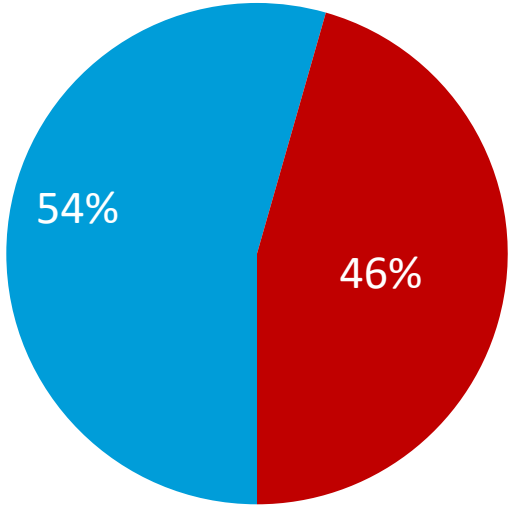

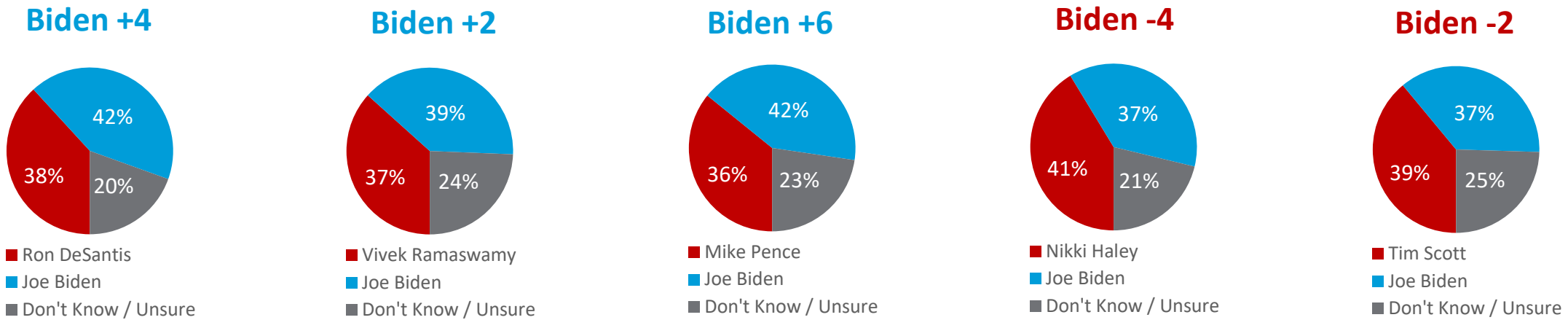

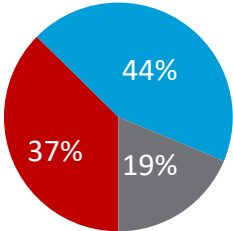

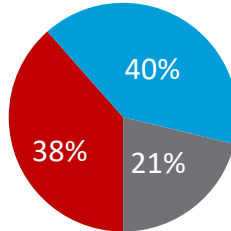

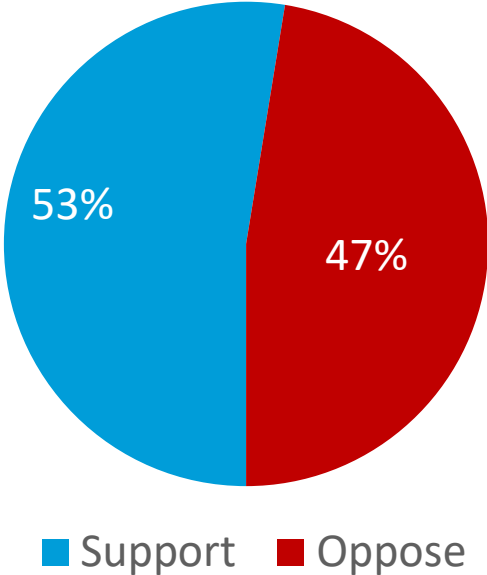

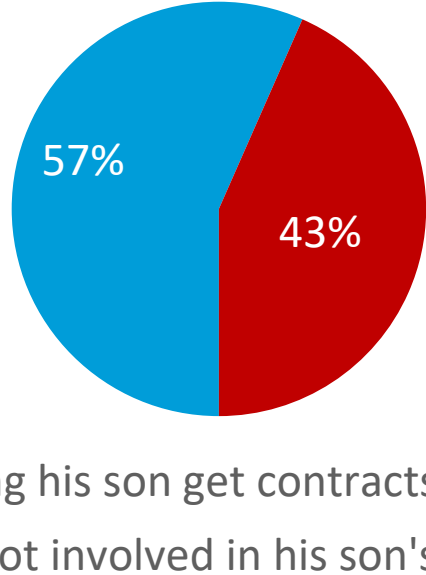

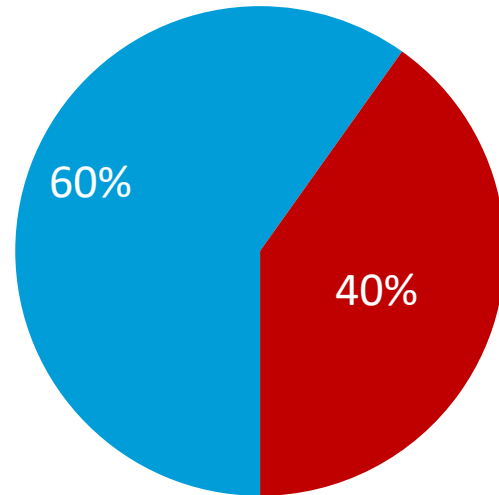

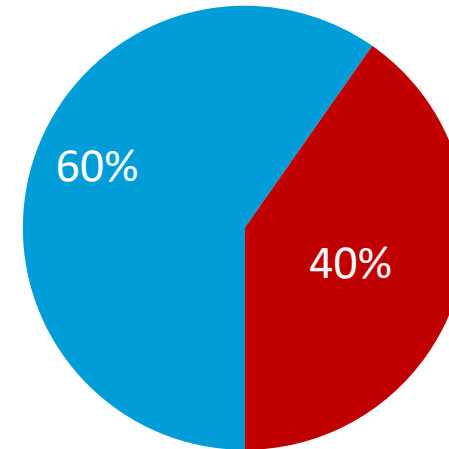

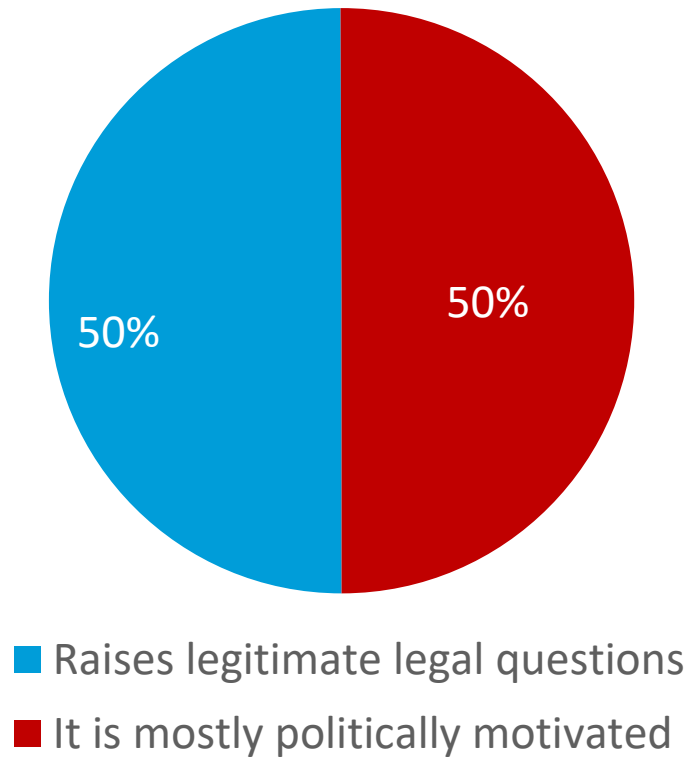

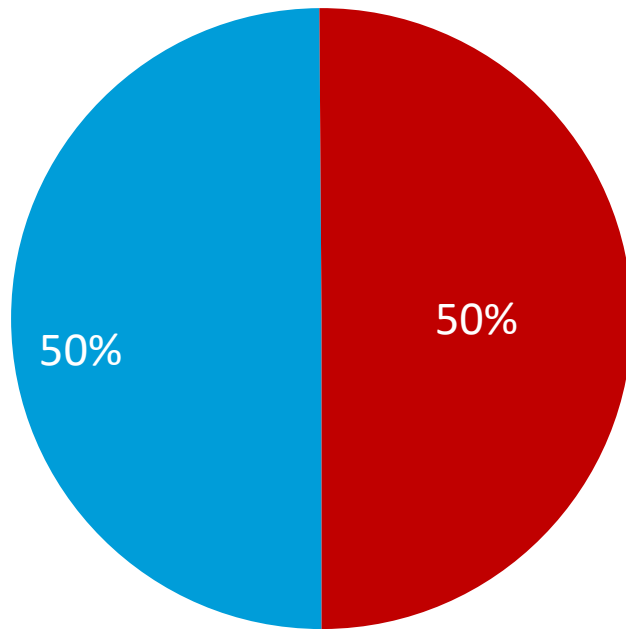

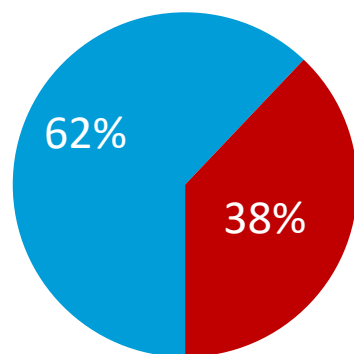

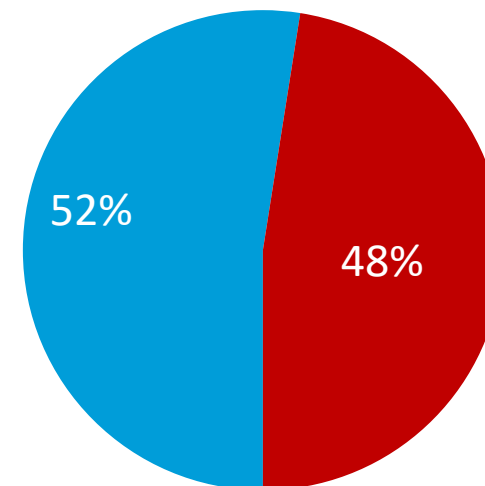

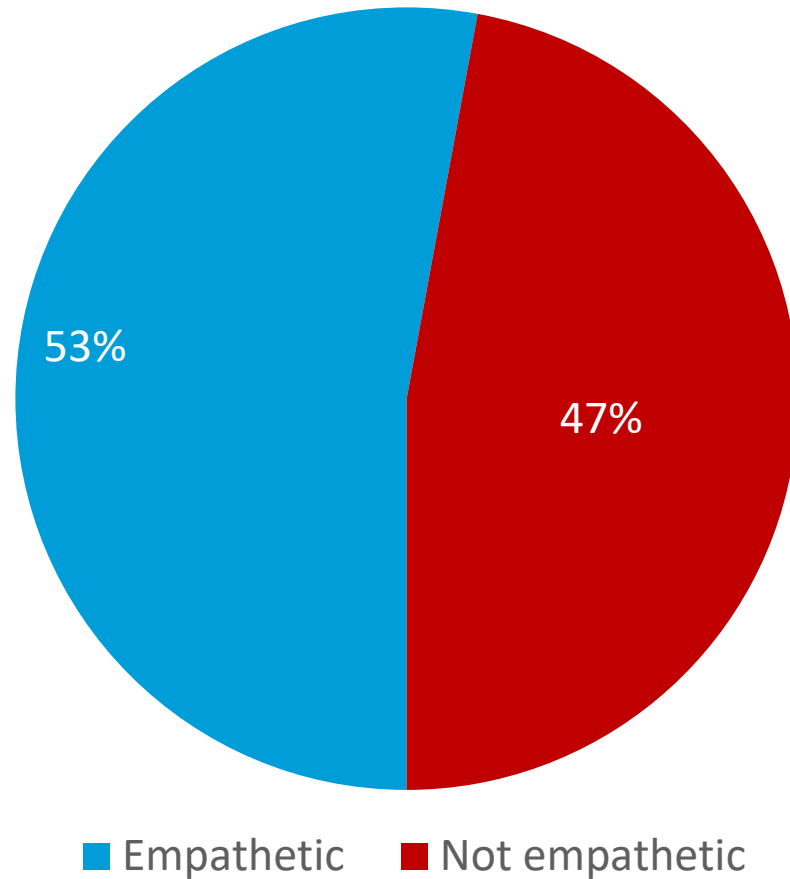

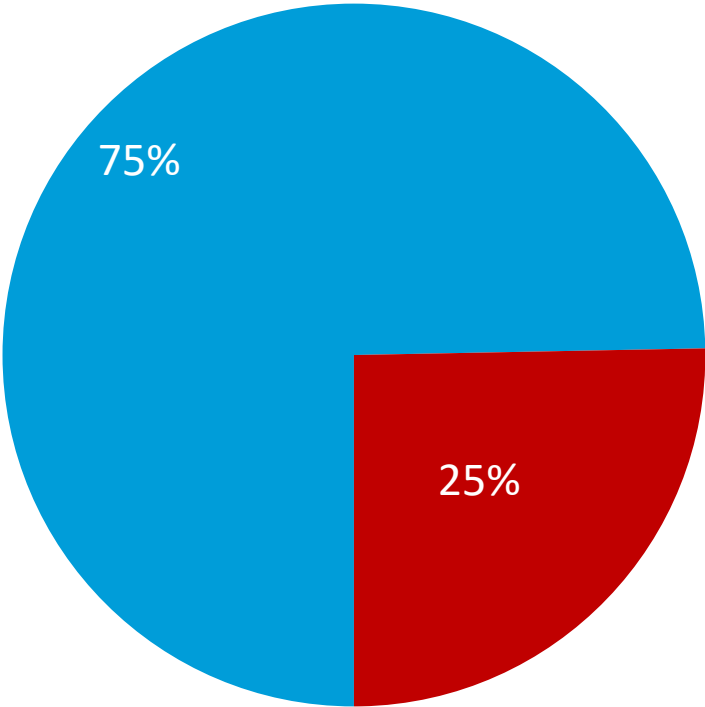

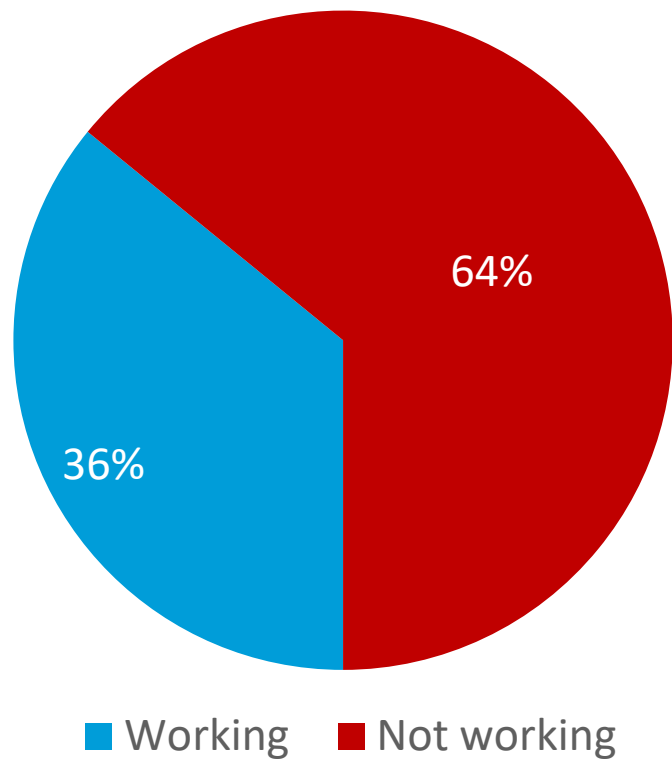

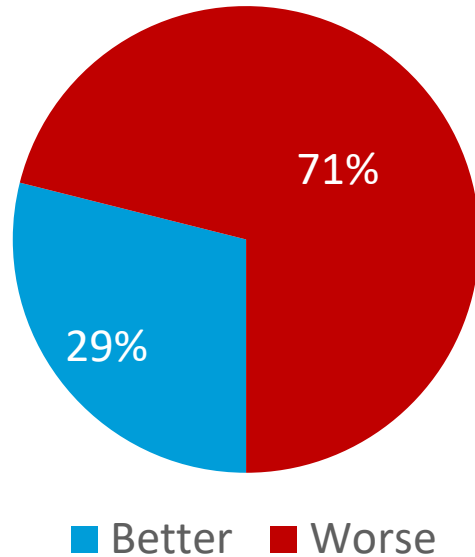

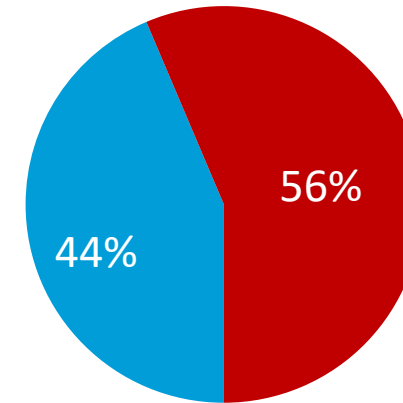

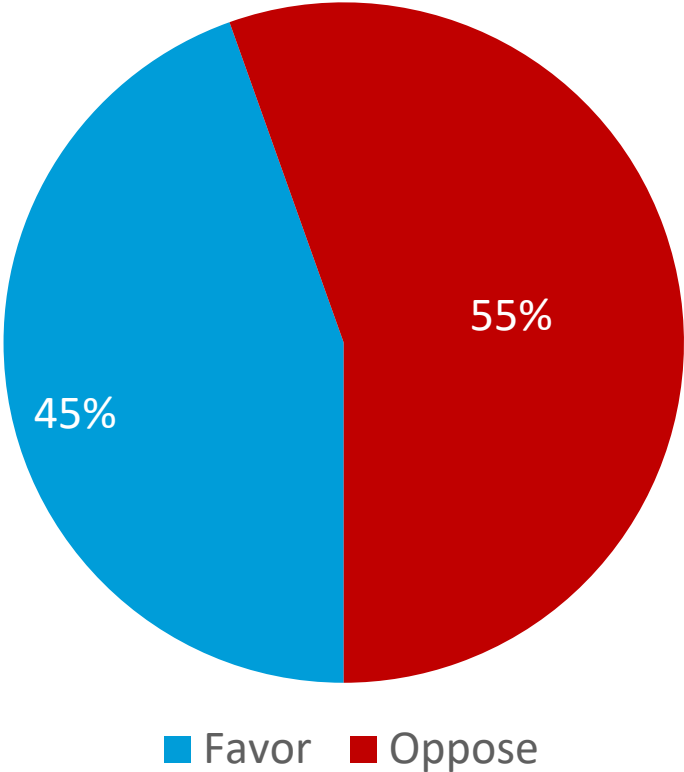

# MOST VOTERS OPPOSE SANCTUARY CITIES; MAJORITY OF DEMOCRATS FAVOR THEM

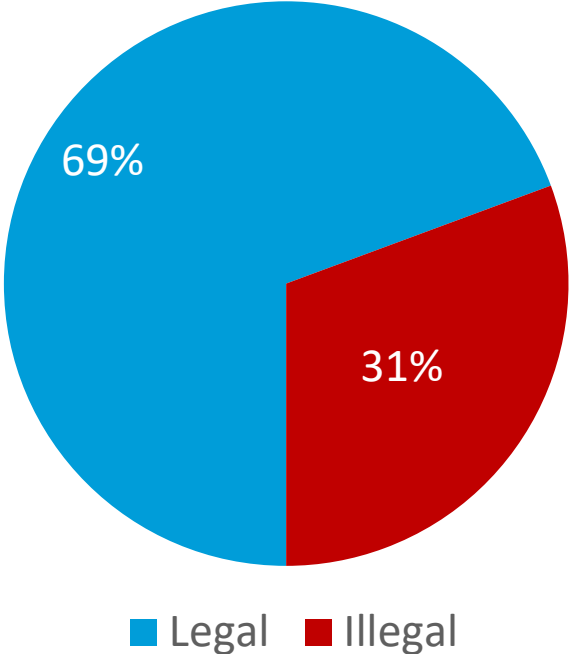
Do you favor or oppose sanctuary cities that limit or deny cooperation with federal agencies in enforcing immigration law?

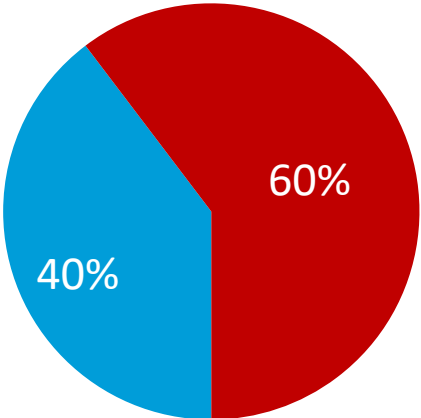

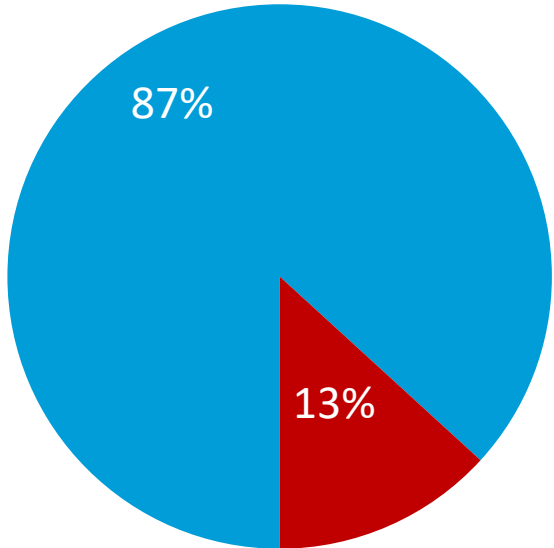

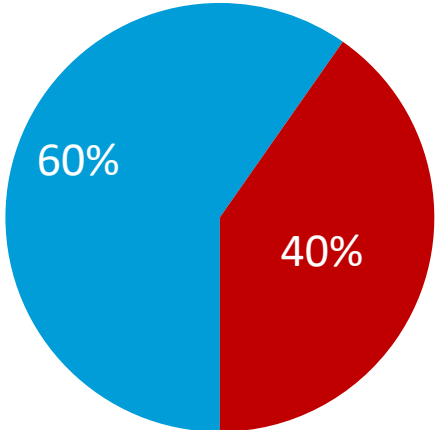
